Save the Date: Fun in the Sun!

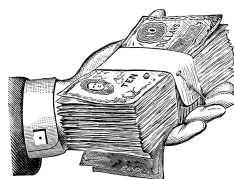

Suggested items include:

Mop and bucket, broom and dust pan, toilet bowl and brush, laundry basket, waste basket, laundry detergent, mold resistant shower curtains, general cleaning products, rubber gloves, dish soap, sponges, scrubbies, oven mitts, dish towels and gift cards.

The collection will take place during the month of July. Please bring items and leave at the entrances of the church. Thank you for helping our neighbors as they move from shelter to housing.
